

# Climate Change Hurts Women Worst

## Station 1. Hunger

- Women feed their children first, their husbands second, and themselves last.
- When climate change brings drought or floods or changes in temperature, their harvests dwindle.
- Then the meals they prepare grow smaller and less nutritious



## Station 2. Poverty

- Climate change harms farming, which causes families to have less money and food.
- Women have less access to credit, so they can't buy better seed adapted to climate change.
- Families can't afford to send their children to school and need children to work at home. This creates a vicious cycle of poverty.

## Station 3. Migration

- As climate change gets worse, women make a choice: stay and hope that things get better or take their chances by migrating.
- If they migrate, they face the danger of being a victim of human trafficking.
- But with our advocacy, they could have a third option: a better life.
